**822 Sheep** A larger than expected entry with a high percentage of lean lambs and these discounted as high feed costs and shortage of fodder showing. Top price this week £140 for a strong Suffolk X from Will Griffin. General run, if meated, heavy lambs £129.5 from Brad Webb, Will Griffin £128, Acorn Farms to £127 with plenty of pens £120 to £124. Medium lambs to £121.50 from Glen Goodman with Will Griffin to £120 and Glen Goodman again at £118.50. Majority £110 to £117 a head. Standard lambs selective with best to £110 a head from Mark Taylor but majority £82 to £100. Top price per kg this week seeing Glen Goodman to 279pkg, the same vendor to 3276 for medium lambs. Heavy lambs to 275pkg from W & J Griffin with majority around 250pkg. Standard lambs to 282pkg from M Taylor with Andrew King to 263pkg. The trade definitely less but still above most quotations for Monday and Tuesday across the country with a £20 difference between fed and lean lambs seen.
