Quality Limousin X heifer from Pauline Byam to 308.5pkg with Pauling having similar bred steer at the same level. Strong Blonde X heifer from Graham & Heather Blythe to 288.50pkg with BBX heifer from the same vendor to 289.5pkg as was Liam Byam for a similar bred heifer. R W Revell to 291.5pkg for a Limousin X heifer with our own Charlie Bowes to 284.5pkg for a Limousin X heifer. Gary Hubert to 288.5pkg for AAX steers with others to 278.5pkg with good cover. Geoff Grover showing quality lightweight steers to 306.5pkg with others to 297.5pkg. Generally, thick R grade steers and heifers 245.5 to 278.5pkg throughout with all easily clearing. A quality entry from Mint & Mustard Produce Ltd to £161 a head (2 pens) with others to £160 (4 pens). Top price per kg 400pkg for standard lambs from Mark & Jake Taylor with Will Ralph to 395pkg and Richard Criddle to 283pkg. Stronger lambs around 340 to 370pkg from various producers. Trade strengthening as quality improves. Old Season Lambs, again all qualities forward but meat is important. A high number of teeth showing but these selling to a good trade if meat. Heavy OSL to £170 from W & J Griffin who had other pens at £166, £165 etc. Becky Dixon also £165 with Miss Evi Dixon to £162. Jack Peacock to £160 (2) as again were Becki Dixon and Evi Dixon. Medium OSL to £146 from Becky Dixon, £145 etc with James Chamley to £144 (2). Standard OSL lacking finish in general but where meat 37kg from Mark & Jake Taylor to £117.50, £116 etc with D M Farms to £116 and Becky Dixon to £115.50. Top price per kg for OSL saw Jack Peacock to 353pkg for medium OSL with Will Griffin to 335pkg for heavier and Jack Peacock to 332pkg for heavy, Becky Dixon to 327pkg as was D M Farms with Shadwell Estates to 326pkg.
